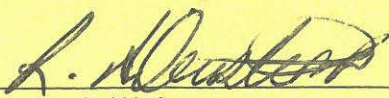

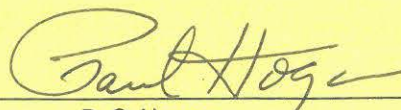
In the opinion of the Board of Judges, TRAINER, AUTHORIZED AGENT, TRAVIS WILLIAM ELLIS, PERM. ADD.: TRURO, NOVA SCOTIA, CANADA, D.O.B. JANUARY 22, 1992, did violate HORSE RACING ALBERTA Rule 123(1)(2); Any person who is responsible for a race horse stabled on the grounds of a race track for the purpose of racing must ensure that a negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins test) dated in the preceding twelve (12) months (365 days) has been issued with respect to that horse. No person may bring a horse onto the grounds of a race track, or permit entry of a horse onto the grounds of a race track, unless a certificate of a negative test for equine infectious anemia has been issued with respect to that horse in accordance with subsection (1); for having a horse in the barn area without a current Coggins test.

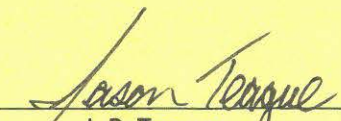
PENALTY: TRAVIS ELLIS is hereby FINED THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100).

In accordance with HORSE RACING ALBERTA Rule 297(1) fine to be paid within ten (10) days.
