HARNESS RULING #83

MEETING: Century Mile Racetrack & Casino

October 16, 2024

In the opinion of the Board of Judges, AUTHORIZED AGENT, TRAINER/OWNER, TRAVIS WILLIAM ELLIS, PERM. ADD.: TRURO, NOVA SCOTIA, CANADA, D.O.B. JANUARY 22, 1992, did violate HORSE RACING ALBERTA Rule 123(1)(2); Any person who is responsible for a racehorse stabled on the grounds of a racetrack for the purpose of racing must ensure that a negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins test) dated in the preceding 12 months (365 days), has been issued with respect to that horse. No person may bring a horse onto the grounds of a racetrack or permit the entry of a horse onto the grounds of a racetrack, unless a certificate of a negative test for equine infectious anemia has been issued with respect to that horse in accordance with subsection (1); for having a horse on the grounds with an expired negative Coggins test.


PENALTY: TRAVIS ELLIS is hereby FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00).
